



Ways to Give to the Southern Appalachian Highlands Conservancy Through Your Will

A bequest, or gifts made through a will, is one of the simplest ways to make a charitable gift to the Southern Appalachian Highlands Conservancy. Bequests allow you to retain control of your assets during your lifetime and reduce your estate taxes. Through a bequest, you may make a contribution to be used for general or specific purposes of land and water conservation and stewardship or make a contribution to an existing fund, such as an endowment. Either option ensures that your charitable wishes will be carried out for the benefit of our mountain region.

Here is some suggested language you could use:

I give and bequeath to the Southern Appalachian Highlands Conservancy, a nonprofit 501(c)3 corporation with a current business address of 372 Merrimon Ave, Asheville, North Carolina 28801 (*all the residue of my estate OR stated percentage of estate OR a state sum Or specific assets*) for the benefit of the Southern Appalachian Highlands Conservancy to be used for its general purposes or (add appropriate language from choices below):

- For the Southern Appalachian Highlands Conservancy to use for general purposes of land conservation, stewardship and education.
- For the Southern Appalachian Highlands Conservancy to use for land and conservation easement acquisition (and/or stewardship) projects.
